

## *Minkowitz's work in collection at Museum of Art and Design*

Norma Minkowitz will be represented in the exhibition "Intertwined: Contemporary Baskets and Sculpture from the Sara and David Lieberman Collection" at the Museum of Arts and Design, 2 Columbus Circle, New York City, on view through Sept. 12.

This internationally acclaimed collection has been assembled over the course of three decades. With their passion for collecting contemporary art and their exceptional openness to new forms and ideas, the Liebermans have assembled one of the best compilations of contemporary art baskets in the country.

"Intertwined" provides an international look at contemporary basket making, offering insight into the evolution of the basket form from a useful object to a work of art and challenging the notion of what defines a basket. The exhibition includes more than 70 traditional and non-traditional objects. The entire collection is a promised gift to the Museum of Arts and Design.

The title of Minkowitz's sculpture is "Sisters," created in 1998 and is a mixed media work measuring 43x21x19. This is the fourth sculpture that Minkowitz will have in the museum's permanent collection. Her sculptures are included in 25 museum collections and she has been awarded artist grants including an NEA and two CT Commission on the Arts Individual Artist Fellowships. Minkowitz is represented by Brown/Grotta Arts in Wilton, an international dealer in the fiber arts.
